

WINDAROO LAKES COVID-19 LATEST UPDATE 14/05/2020

STATUS –	Golf Course	- Open with new safe practices – now 4 per group

As of Saturday 16 May 2020, as part of stage one of the Queensland Government Roadmap to ease Queensland's restrictions, golf bookings are back to 4 per group and single ride carts remain. **RESTAURANT will commence dining from the 16/05/2020. This will be limited to 10 people at any one time and max booking of 6 per group with a max of 1 hour sitting. The serving of limited alcohol is available whilst you consume a meal only. BOOKINGS ESSENTIAL.** All dining must observe social distancing of 1.5m and at least 1 person per four square metres of space always.

As of 12 June 2020, it is planned, that under stage two restrictions, this will increase to 20 people for the above activities and as of 10 July 2020, it is planned that under stage three, registered and licensed clubs may re-open, with limits of 100 people. This will extend to bar and gaming activities.

We have made some significant changes to the Time Sheets from this Saturday 15th May. Please check all bookings from this date as we have had to manipulate timesheet back to **groups of 4**. All bookings times have changed to suit new timesheet setup.

We will continue with One Tee Start only from 6:25am to 13:05pm for 18 Holes and 13:13 to 15:21 for 9 Holes. With a one tee start we are still 52 tee times short of our normal 2 tee start. We will implement 2 tee start again once social distancing requirements have been reduced.

New Cart FEES and reduced Comp Fee Levy times will apply to all playing rights as of Saturday

1. **Comp Fee Levy**
 - a. **MEMBERS** Daily Comp Fee Levy of \$15 fee now only applies to selected tee times per day
 - b. **Non-comp** levy tee times are now also available
 - c. All competitions will be Single Stableford
2. **Carts Fee's**
 - a. **Corporate** \$15 extra for extra 2 carts if required
 - b. **Cart Members** \$5 levy for single use
 - c. **Cart Fee Single Ride** \$25 - 18 Holes and \$15 for 9 Holes
3. **Visitor, Guests and Lifestyle green Fee's**
 - a. **18 Holes**
 - i. Monday to Friday \$30 walking, \$55 including Cart
 - ii. Saturday \$40 walking, \$65 including Cart
 - iii. Sunday \$50 walking, \$75 including Cart
 - b. **9 Holes**
 - i. Monday to Friday \$20 walking, \$35 including Cart
 - ii. Saturday \$25 walking, \$45 including Cart
 - iii. Sunday \$30 walking, \$55 including Cart

In this time of extenuating circumstances, we as a Privately Owned Club, are trying to maintain the golf course in the excellent condition that we believe it is in, as well as provide a place of relaxation and exercise for our Members. Our income streams have been dramatically affected; we are in the fight of our lives to keep this great club alive.

Effective from 12:00am Tuesday the 31st of March the following rules will apply to all members and guests. Failure to comply will result in immediate exclusion from the golf course.

- CASHLESS, only credit card and Eftpos may be accepted as a form of payment until notice.
- Alcohol CANNOT be purchased from the Pro Shop or Coffee Shop for consumption on the Golf Course or takeaway
 - Liquor may be purchased from clubhouse after golf for takeaway purposes only
- No alcohol to be brought onto the course by players.
 - The course is still licensed and restrictions have been imposed.
- The requirements of [social distancing](#) are to be adhered to while playing, i.e. at least 1.5m from the nearest person.
- Only 10 people at a time may enter via Pro Shop, please be patient and follow all directions by staff.
- NEW LOCAL RULES - The R&A – Temporary Modifications to the Rules of Golf – EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY
 - Players may enter their own hole scores on the scorecard (it is not necessary for a marker to do it).
 - It is not necessary to have a marker physically certify the player's hole scores, however it is critical some form of verbal certification takes place.
 - Score cards to be placed in the "scorecard return box" in front of coffee shop - Staff will enter scores
 - Carts are only to be used as "single use" only unless from the same household. All carts will be charged out as "single use" and must be booked with the golf shop.
 - Shared carts are also ok as long as one player walks.
 - Bookings are essential.
 - Flagsticks - all players are required to leave the flagstick in the hole at all times.
 - Bunkers - preferred lies in bunkers. players can smooth bunkers using their feet or a club before placing ball on the preferred lie

When players are finished their game, all players MUST leave the course immediately and not congregate around the clubhouse.

Any player not complying with the above will face disciplinary action and could also result in the course being closed.

Members should exhibit a heightened awareness of personal hygiene as has been encouraged by state and federal health departments.
